And now we get to share it with you. We can't wait for you to enjoy your time with us here in Wondernauld. Thanks for joining us.



#### <mark>GARY MCNAIR</mark> Writer



Gary McNair is a writer and performer from Glasgow. He aims to make work that will entertain and challenge audiences in equal measure. His work has been translated into several languages and performed around the world from America to Australia, Germany to Japan, and from Portugal to Possilpark. He is a mainstay of the Edinburgh Fringe where his last seven shows have sold out and he has won the coveted Scotsman Fringe First Award three times.

He is Writer in Residence at the National Theatre of Scotland and is an Associate Artist at both the Traverse Theatre in Edinburgh and the Tron in Glasgow. He loves telling stories and is delighted that people want to hear them.

Recent works include; Dear Billy (National Theatre of Scotland), Nae Expectations (The Tron), Jekyll and Hyde (Reading Rep/ The Lyceum), Black Diamonds and the Blue Brazil (The Lyceum), The Alchemist (The Tron), Square Go [co-authored by Kieran Hurley] (Francesca Moody Productions/Paines Plough), McGonagall's Chronicles (Oran Mor), Locker Room Talk/ Letters to Morrissey (The Traverse), and A Gambler's Guide To Dying (Show and Tell/ The Traverse).



#### <mark>JO RUSH</mark> Director



Jo Rush is a director, theatre-maker, and dramaturg, who specialises in supporting writers and artists in the development of new work. She co-directed the 2022 tour of Adam McNamara's police drama Stand By and is currently developing Star o' the Bar, a new devised piece of pub theatre with performer Jo Freer. Through the Capital Theatres and Pitlochry Festival Theatre Musical Commissioning Hub she led the development of Rebel, a new Scottish musical by composer Tommy Antonio. She has premiered new work at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival over the last ten years, including Ivory Wings by Susie Coreth, Mary the Last Farewell by RA Stevens, and devised piece Hide & Seek.

Jo developed and co-directed the sitespecific promenade production Design by Disaster, by Dave Fargnoli in 2018, for the University of Edinburgh with Braw Fox Theatre. Through the Royal Academy of Engineering's Ingenious Award she led the innovative 'CreateWorks' project to develop and produce original audio plays written by engineers and inspired by their specialist research. She has worked as an associate director in theatres across Scotland, including Black Diamonds and the Blue Brazil (Lyceum and PFT Sound Stage), My Friend Selma (Terra Incognita) and The Cheviot, The Stag, and the Black, Black Oil (National Theatre of Scotland).



#### BRIAN JAMES O'SULLIVAN Composer



Brian is a composer, actor and comedian from Glasgow. Recent composing works include *The Thinkery* and *My Name is Sarah and...* (A Play, a Pie and a Pint). As a comedian, he recently completed his solo trilogy, *Uh Huh: The Janice & Frank Story* (*parts I, II and III*), and as an actor recently appeared in *Macbeth* (Donmar Warehouse) and as *Maw Goose* (Macrobert Arts Centre) was the recipient of Best Dame in the UK Pantomime Awards 2022.

Natasha studied Theatre, Film and Television at the University of Glasgow.
